

EUDR - information on packaging materials

Deutronic packaging materials

EU Regulation (EU) 2023/1115 on deforestation-free supply chains (“EUDR”) regulates the placing on the market of certain raw materials (including wood) and products made from them in the European Union. Packaging may fall under this regulation if it is traded as a standalone product and falls within the scope of the EUDR (Annex I).

Use of cardboard boxes and pallets at Deutronic

At Deutronic, cardboard boxes and pallets are used exclusively as packaging and transport materials for electronic products. They serve to support, protect, and carry the devices and are not marketed or sold by Deutronic as independent goods.

According to the current interpretation of the EUDR, these packaging materials are therefore covered by the exemption for packaging used exclusively for the protection, support, or transport of another product placed on the market.

From today's perspective, the cardboard boxes and pallets used by Deutronic are not directly subject to the due diligence obligations of the EUDR, as they are used exclusively as packaging and transport materials for non-wood products (electronic devices) and are not placed on the market as independent products.

Deutronic is monitoring the further clarification of the EUDR (guidance, FAQ, etc.) and will adapt this document to new legal or regulatory requirements as necessary.
